



20 POSTDOCTORAL RESEARCH SCHOLARSHIPS 2014 LAW AND MANAGEMENT STUDIES

For the 2014 intake on its postdoctoral programmes, the College invites applications for 20 Postdoctoral Research positions.

Twenty Postdoctoral Research Scholarship packages are available to highly motivated individuals to engage in full-time postdoctoral research under the supervision of a member of the academic staff in one of the four Schools of the College (the Graduate School of Business & Leadership; the School of Accounting, Economics & Finance; the School of Law; and the School of Management, IT & Governance).

The scholarship consists of a yearly non-taxable stipend of R180 000.00 and R20 000.00 for expenses. These positions are renewable for a second year, subject to satisfactory progress.

Application Requirements

- A doctoral degree obtained in the last three years.
- A CV including a list of publications.
- A one page proposal indicating the research area and the proposed project(s).
- A CV of the supervisor if a relationship with one already exists within the UKZN College of Law and Management Studies.
- A certified academic record.
- Applicants should not be older than 45 years of age by the closing date of applications.
- Candidate to be based at UKZN for the duration of the scholarship.
- Completion of the application form.

Required Outputs

- The candidate is expected to have a minimum of one article accepted for publication in the first year and proof that a second article has been submitted and is under review. The article must be in DoHET accredited journals.
